IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR GUESTS

Please be aware that Dublin Castle, located adjacent to The Chancery Hotel, is currently serving as the secure venue for Ireland's Presidency of the Council of the European Union and is closed to the public until 31 December 2026.

As part of the security arrangements implemented by An Garda Síochána, access to Dublin Castle, including the State Apartments, Dubh Linn Gardens, and the Chester Beatty Library, is restricted. In addition, road and pedestrian access in the surrounding area may be subject to periodic security measures and temporary disruptions through January 2027.

The Chancery Hotel remains fully accessible and open to guests. However, you may experience occasional traffic diversions, pedestrian route changes, increased security presence, or minor delays when travelling to and from the hotel.

To help ensure smooth access to the hotel, we recommend that guests have their reservation details readily available upon arrival. During your stay, please carry your hotel key card with you when entering and leaving the property, as this may help facilitate access through any security checkpoints or temporary access controls in the area.

We recommend allowing a little extra time for your journey and thank you for your understanding while these important international events are taking place.
